



By the Numbers



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Preadmission Screening & Resident Review (PASRR)

PASRR Level I

Identify possible SMI and/or ID/RC prior to admission and upon significant change in condition within Medicaidcertified Nursing Facility (NF).

PASRR Level II Evaluation

Level I review for categorical admissions. Face-to-face assessment to confirm presence of SMI/ID/RC and assess the need for NF level of care and/or specialized services.

PASRR Level II Determination

Notify individuals and providers of the results and include recommendations for NF care plans. Document and follow specialized services recommendations.
